Please respond to that email before Thursday, July 21st and let us know if you would like to keep your spot, change your spot, or take a break from lessons. If you are keeping the same spot, our staff will enroll your child in the 2022-2023 School Year Session, and your credit card on file will be charged for September's lessons around August 20th. In a few weeks, please login to your Parent Portal account in Jackrabbit to confirm the day, time and instructor. IF WE DO NOT HEAR BACK FROM YOU BY JULY 21ST, WE WILL ASSUME THAT YOU WANT TO KEEP THE SAME SPOT AS THE PREVIOUS SCHOOL YEAR AND WILL ENROLL YOUR CHILD(REN).

If you would like to change spots, were on a waitlist this year, or were enrolled this summer, you can enroll during Priority Registration on Monday, August 8th at 10:00AM.

If you are new to Little Strokes Swim Academy or haven't swum with us in the past year or so, you can enroll during General Public Registration on Monday, August 15th at 10:00AM.
