A FRIENDLY REMINDER!

Makeup Lessons

Makeup lessons stay on your account for **one year** from the missed lesson, and you **do not** need to be currently enrolled to schedule a makeup lesson!



We've had a lot of questions regarding makeup lessons lately:

- * Makeup lessons stay on your account for one year from the absence/cancellation date
- * Your swimmer does not need to be currently enrolled to schedule makeups
- * Makeup lessons can be used on different levels

If your swimmer has a makeup lesson on their account, they DO NOT need to use it during the current session. Makeups from the School Year Session can be used during the Summer Session, even if your child is not enrolled in the Summer Session. Makeup lessons stay on your account for one full year and can be used on different level classes. If your child has Parent-Tot makeups but is now over the age of 2, they can use them for Age Group lessons. Similarly, Age Group makeup lessons can be used for Swim Team practice.
